24 million children under the age of 12 call the United States home. By the time they are teenagers:

- ❖ 1 out of 10 will have been sexually active prior to his or her 13th birthday
- ❖ 1 out of 10 eighth graders will smoke daily
- ❖ 1 out of 5 will have tried drugs in the past year
- ❖ 1 out of 3 will have gotten drunk in the past year

This will only change if we are able to influence their moral foundation, which is formed by age 9.

Of the four generations living together in the U.S. there has been an alarming spiritual decline in the lives of people. Only 4% of people between the ages of 11 and 25 claim to be Christians compared to 65% three generations before. There are 80 million people in this age bracket - if they were a separate country it would be the 7th largest mission field in the world.

At this rate of decline what will happen to this generation of children? What will happen to the 24 million children under the age of 12?

We can't afford to neglect the missions in our own backyard. These children need to know about the love of Jesus.
